

Proposed change to Article II. Directors and Officers, Section 1 is:

Requirements for holding office. Any member running for office must meet the following requirements;

1. Membership in good standing for one (1) year;
2. All dues paid;
3. No felony convictions (Extenuating circumstances can be presented to the Board of Directors and will be dealt with in the same manner as Article V, Section 8)
4. Must be 21 years of age or older.
5. Directors and Officers must live in a school district that is in Schoharie County.

Original language in Article II. Directors and Officers, Section 1 is:

Requirements for holding office. Any member running for office must meet the following requirements:

1. Membership in good standing for one (1) year;
2. All dues paid;
3. No felony convictions (Extenuating circumstances can be presented to the Board of Directors and will be dealt with in the same manner as Article V, Section 8.)
4. Must be 21 years of age or older.

Proposed change to Article V, Membership and Dues, Section 5 is:

Any Member 65 years of age or more having been a member in good standing for ten (10) years or more, including the probationary period, will be given a free lifetime membership.

Original language in Article V, Membership and Dues, Section 5 is:

Any member 60 years of age or more having been a member in good standing for ten (10) years or more, including the probationary period, will be given a free lifetime membership.

Proposed change to Article V, Membership and Dues, Section 7 is:

Lifetime membership in the Club may be purchased by any member of the Club after Ten (10) consecutive years of good standing in the Club, for five (5) years of the current dues payable in five consecutive monthly payments or less. If a member fails to complete these terms of payment, the money already submitted will be applied to yearly dues; no money will be refunded.

Original language in Article V, Membership and Dues, Section 7 is:

Lifetime membership in the Club may be purchased by any member of the Club after five (5) consecutive years of good standing in the Club, for two hundred fifty (250) dollars payable in five consecutive monthly payments or less. If a member fails to complete these terms of payment, the money already submitted will be applied to yearly dues; no money will be refunded.

Proposed change to Article V. Membership and Dues, Section 13 is;

During any scheduled event, the Range Officer, New York State Certified Training Instructor, or person in charge has full authority over Club and its grounds. During non-scheduled, individual use of the Club's outdoor parallel ranges, new pistol range behind the Club Meeting room and only one (1) other range can be used at a time. It is the member's responsibility to use the "RANGE IN USE" sign attached to the outside corner of the indoor archery range when they are using a range. They are also responsible for removing the "in use" sign when they are finished.

Original language to Article V. Membership and Dues, Section 13 is:

During any scheduled event, the Range Officer, New York State Certified Training Instructor, or person in charge has full authority over the Club and its grounds. During non-scheduled, individual use of the Club's outdoor parallel ranges, only one (1) range can be used at a time. It is the member's responsibility to use the "RANGE IN USE" sign attached to the outside corner of the indoor archery range when they are using a range. They are also responsible for removing the "in use" sign when they are finished.

Proposed change to Article VIII. Range Rules – Safety, Section 3 is:

There will be no simultaneous use of the outdoor ranges with the exception of the NYS Hunter Safety Course. Unless simultaneous use consists of the New Pistol Range behind The Club Meeting Room and any one (1) of the other club outdoor Ranges. It is the member's responsibility to use the "RANGE IN USE SIGN" attached to the outside corner of the indoor archery range. They are also responsible for removing the "in use" sign when finished.

Original language in Article VIII. Range Rules – Safety, Section 3 is:

There will be no simultaneous use of the outdoor ranges, with the exception of the NYS Hunter Safety Course. It is the member's responsibility to use the "RANGE IN USE SIGN" attached to the outside corner of the indoor archery range. They are also responsible for removing the "in use" sign when finished.

Proposed change to Article VIII. Range Rules – Safety, Section 5 is:

Anyone that will be handling a handgun on club property must have or be one of the following: Have a valid New York State Pistol License, Be in the age bracket of the NYS law to handle a handgun with a licensed pistol permit holder, Be a Law Enforcement Officer Allowed to handle a handgun in New York State, Be legally allowed to own and possess a handgun in your home state and legally be allowed to bring it to New York State to participate in an event with a Handgun, i.e. NRA sanctioned shooting event. (NYS Law S265.20 of the penal law exemptions, section 13)

Original language in Article VIII. Range Rules – Safety, Section 5 is:

Prior to registration in any event involving the use of handguns, the participant must produce a valid New York State license to carry a pistol to the registrar of the event.
